At Migis Lodge, you'll stay in one of our Main Lodge's 8 spacious rooms or in one of 35 private cottages. MAIN LODGE ROOMS

Accessible Accommodations Located at the Heart of The Lodge

We have 8 deluxe rooms on the second floor of our Main Lodge. Each features a private bathroom, king or twin beds, sitting area with corner gas fireplace, and individual balconies with lovely views of the lake. Two-person minimum, and a special rate for solo travelers.

STUDIO COTTAGES

Perfect for Couples

Our two side-by-side studio cottages feature one king or two queen beds, corner fieldstone fireplaces, sitting area, private full bathrooms, and elevated front porches with lake views. Two-person minimum.

ONE BEDROOM COTTAGES

Preferred Choice of Small Families

Our 16 one-bedroom cottages feature front porches with rockers and lake views, living rooms with cathedral ceilings and fieldstone fireplaces. Each has a separate bedroom with one king or two queen beds. Every living room has a pullout sofa. Two person minimum.

TWO & THREE BEDROOM COTTAGES

Ideal for Families with older children or couples traveling together

Our five, two bedroom and eight, three-bedroom cottages provide front porches with lake views and spacious living rooms with fieldstone fireplace. The cottages have first and sometimes second floor bedrooms. Bedrooms vary in size and have one king, one queen, or two twin beds. All primary bedrooms have king beds. Most living rooms have pullout sofa. Four-person minimum.

FOUR+ BEDROOM COTTAGES

Perfect for large groups or multi-generational families

Ideal choice for a larger group or a multi-generational family. These four cottages vary and each has unique features; some have private balconies, one has a wraparound screened porch, one a private deck and garden, and one has a private beach. Each has a living room with fieldstone fireplace and pullout couch. Bedrooms vary in size and have either king, queen, double, or twin beds. Four, six, and 10 person minimums.

We offer a variety of boating activities at Migis Lodge, ranging from sailing aboard a classic Sunfish sailboat, to paddleboarding, canoeing, kayaking, motorboating, and leisurely lake cruises. When you want to explore a bit further out on the lake, we have a variety of powerboats available for rent, ranging from 14-foot Lunds equipped with 15 horsepower engines to a performance powerboat and comfortable pontoon boat, perfect for larger families. We offer massage therapy treatments with Maine Bodyworks at our massage and wellness center, a cozy cabin in a quiet part of the property with a relaxing screened in waiting area and showers on a private deck. The treatment rooms are comfortable spaces with windows that open to the breezes and the relaxing sounds of nature.

Main Lodge Dining Room

In the Main Lodge dining room, we serve breakfast, lunch and dinner, with the exception of Friday nights when Lobster Bake is served outside at Cookout Point. Migis tradition requires dressy attire for ladies and gentlemen over the age of 13 for dinner after 5:30 pm when dinner is served in the Main Lodge dining room.

Breakfast

We serve breakfast each day from 8 am to 9:30 am, with coffee available at 6 am by the fire in the living room. On breakfast cookout days, no breakfast buffet will be served in the dining room. For our guests who like to sleep in, we offer coffee and pastries in our living room until 11 am.

Lunch

We offer lunch daily from 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm. The dining room menu changes daily and pre-ordered to-go lunch boxes are available. From Father's Day in June through Labor Day, we offer the choice of lunch at the Main Lodge or at Cookout Point.

Dinner

Dinner is served at the Main Lodge and porch when not at Cookout Point. We offer our nightly changing five-course menu, featuring lobster in addition to a variety of entree choices. Pickup dinner service is available only when dinner service is taking place in the Main Lodge. Dinner at Cookout Point is served two nights per week. Join us before dinner at 5:30 pm on the terrace and enjoy a cocktail or glass of wine from our bar.

Saturday Night Buffet

Join us each Saturday evening for a guest favorite, our gourmet "Buffet Night." We offer an array of great items including lobster, carving station, shrimp, scallops, poached salmon and many Chef's specialties. Our Saturday dessert buffet is not to be missed.

Dress Code

Dressing for dinner is a storied Migis tradition. Beginning at 5:30 pm our dress code applies in the Main Lodge, on the porch and terraces and in the dining room. Required and appropriate clothing include:

- Jackets and collared shirts required (13 and older)
- Khakis, slacks, dress pants, dress capris, skirts, or dresses
- No t-shirts, athletic wear, jeans, or baseball caps

Dining with Children

Children of all ages are most welcome at Migis Lodge, and in consideration of our guests we have the following policy:

Families will be served in the Hancock Room during breakfast and lunch. During dinner, children can participate in our traditional "Zoo" program available starting June 16. This includes, at no additional charge, a supervised children's evening program from 5:30 pm to 9:00 pm with dinner from the special children's menu and supervised playtime after dinner. This enables parents to dine at their leisure in the Main Lodge dining room or Cookout Point.

Children five years of age and under who do not participate in the Zoo program for dinner will be served with their families in our Hancock Room or on the back porch. Children 6 years and older are welcome in the main dining room or Main Lodge porch for dinner.

Lakeside Dining at Migis Lodge

Outdoor dining in the warm summer breeze is one of the hallmarks of the Migis Experience. Share a picnic table with family and friends at Cookout Point for lunch daily, or enjoy our traditional lakeside lobster bake every Friday during June, July, and August.

Lunch Cookout

Every day during the summer we offer a lunch cookout at Cookout Point. In addition to our daily cookout specials, we feature an array of fresh salads, soups, fresh fruit, hamburgers, veggie burgers, hot dogs, grilled fish, grilled chicken, Coney Island onions, baked beans, grilled sandwiches, cookies, brownies, sundaes, iced tea, soda, beer, Migis lemonade, and more!

Sunday & Thursday Breakfast Cookout

On Sunday and Thursday mornings from 8 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. join us at Cookout Point for our traditional breakfast. Fresh squeezed juices, eggs to order, fresh fruit, pancakes, bacon, sausage, and our homemade donuts are just some of the offerings!

On summer Wednesdays, we set sail for Island Cookout! The first Tykona run leaves the cove at noon to cruise across Sebago and tie up on Millstone Island.
